## WILDFLOWER WAY

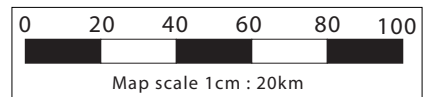
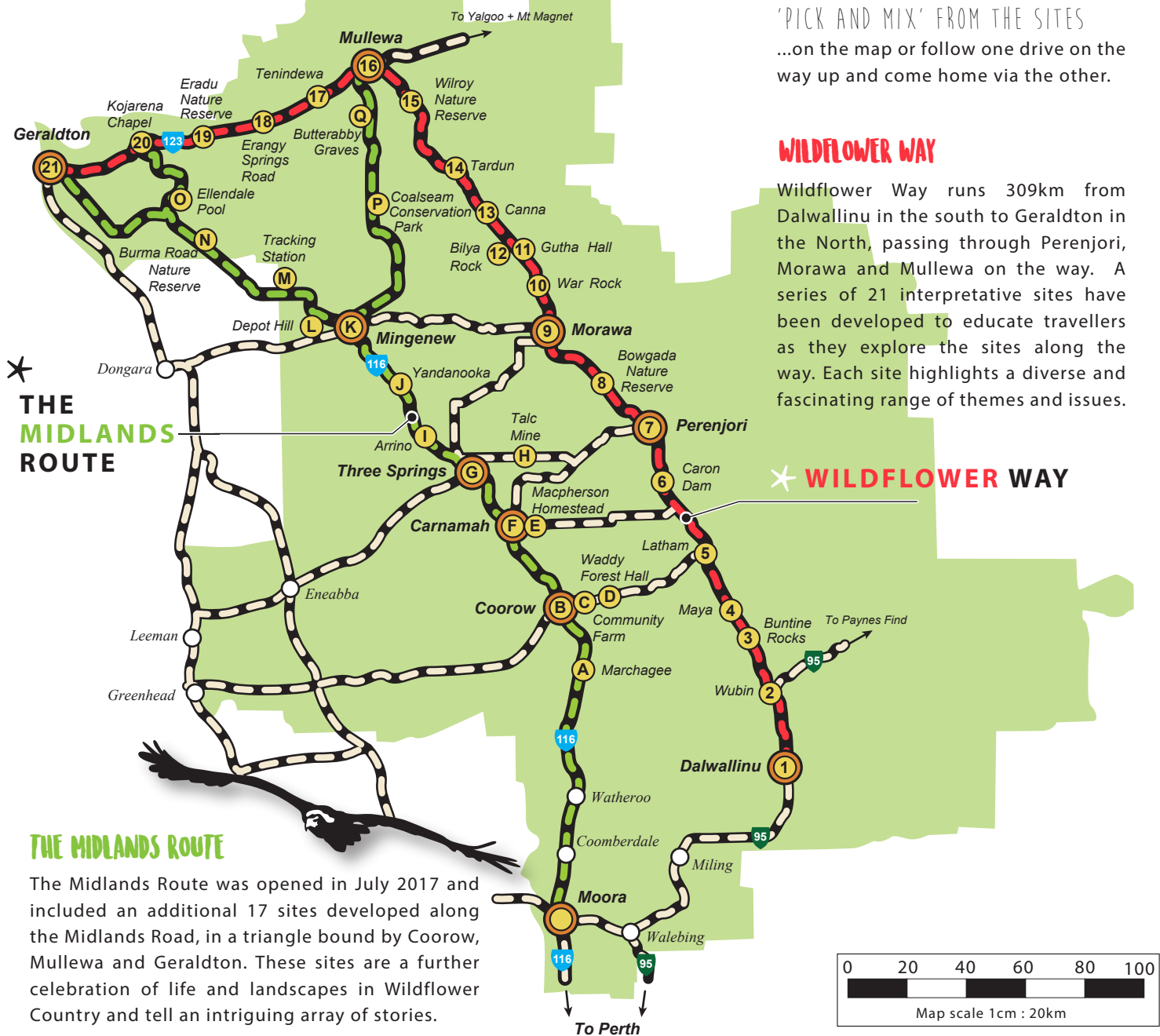
